How did homelessness become so pervasive in California? What policy decisions have communities made over the past decades that have led to millions of people here losing their homes? Who are the homeless and how did they become that way?

Leagues across California are being asked to weigh in on ballot measures that can affect homelessness. It's important to inform ourselves about how policy can create or prevent homelessness.

The League has positions on Housing and Meeting Basic Human Needs, but homelessness is a problem that falls between the cracks of these two related positions. Our 14-month study indicates that homelessness is a unique situation that requires a unique position.
