Report of Actions on Sunday, May 21, 2023

President Carol Moon Goldberg called Convention 2023 back to order at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 21, 2023.

Sunday Plenary: 162 Delegates representing 54 Local Leagues and ILOs.

Delegates approved the LWVC Program for 2023-2025 – See Pages 25-38 of the Convention Workbook:

- Retained current positions
- Adopted Making Democracy Work in California, as an Issue for Education and Advocacy
- Adopted Climate Change and Sustainability, including a focus on Water Resources as an Issue for Education and Advocacy
- Adopted Housing and Homelessness as an Issue for Education and Advocacy
- Adopted Criminal Justice/Juvenile Justice Reform as an Issue for Education and Advocacy.
